

This is a beautiful hummingbird and gardenias piece. We can take reservations for this two-day seminar with a deposit of \$35. You will also need to purchase the paper from Janelle which is \$15 and measures 19 ½ by 12 ¾. Mi-Teintes is not acceptable. The project requires 20 colored pencils which run about a dollar a piece at Michaels. Janelle can order a three-drawer box similar to what she put her project on.

The cost of that box is \$40. But you can either frame your piece, or put it on another object that will measure the size of the project.




Tips and tricks To Resize a Pattern

Simply divide the size of the piece that you want by the size for the pattern you have, then multiply by 100%.

For example, to reduce a pattern that is 15" long to fit a piece that is 12" long divide 12X15 then multiply by 100%. 12 div 15 X 100% = 80%. Scan the pattern at 80% and it should fit perfectly.

Or let's say your pattern is 12" and you want to enlarge it to 15" (15 div 12 X 100%= 125%) Scan the pattern at 125% and will be enlarged to the right size.


