
belt. I really enjoy working with color pencils. It is so relaxing as well as easily portable.



Don't forget to sign in the notebook when you donate!



Our chapter won the Quarterly Memory Box Contest conduct by Tole Friends. For a Total of 252 Boxes Delivered.




Summer Committee meetings will be held. If you would like to be a part of Retreat committees, please call me.
