

This is very important Chapter business. I hope each of you will plan to attend and exercise your right to vote. I shall look forward to seeing you at the meeting.




Gloria mentioned someplace else in this NL that we won the Tolefriends.net contest for chapters – again the second quarter. Keep up the good work gals!

SEMINAR'S AND WORKSHOP'S

POSSIBLE NEW SEMINAR

We have a chance to book Linda Coulter, known for her work with Grisaille, in late August 2007, and have received a contract from her. The contract would be for two days and you would need to take both days. However, Linda's per day fee would run around \$70, or \$140 for the two days. She requires a minimum of 18 students and a maximum of 36 students. The question is whether members are interested in having her come and would they support this fee. We already

have two seminars planned for 2007 (Lynne Deptula in March and Janelle Johnson in June). This would mean a third seminar for 2007.

While the cost at first seems high, she does provide the surface and paints. She would have brushes for sale at the seminar if you wish to purchase them. Before booking this seminar, we need to ensure we have enough people to support it and will be asking for a show of hands at the September meeting. If you cannot attend the meeting but would like to attend such a seminar, we ask that you let Marilyn Hartnett know either by email (mhartnett@centurytel.net) or phone (636-332-0839), since we will be required to send a deposit to hold the booking.

The Gold Brush Award






