
TURNING POINT WOMEN'S SHELTER

We recently received the memory boxes you sent as a part of the Memory Box Program. The boxes are so meaningful, and we are touched by the creative spirit and delicate artwork lovingly put into each box. The boxes are truly beautiful!

I indeed want to thank you for your generous contribution toward healing for the families who will receive your gift. Each box becomes part of a lifelong memory of the short moments families spend on this earth with their beloved child. Your boxes will be cherished.

Our program is called the Neonatal/Pediatric Bereavement Support Program. We provide support to all families who have a baby or child die here at the hospital. Some of the memorial items families place in the memory boxes and take home with them include hand and/or foot prints in ink and also in a plaster-like mold, locks of hair, pictures, bereavement support information, baby bracelets, blankets, hats, booties, and clothing. I can tell you from being with these families that each tangible memory of their child and each acknowledgement that their child was and is loved is indeed priceless.
