Kelly Hoernig has a group doing the same for \$99 and there is one for acrylic painting through the Tolebrush group. Lorie will send out links.

### Program Chair Information presented by Barb:

#### Seminars:

Bobbie Campbell – teaches the class with a No-Float method. She blends the colors using a specific set of blenders. Rules for class:

Can paint on any object you may want but

DO NOT enlarge or reduce the pattern,

You MUST use a specific brand of wood sealer for the method to be successful.Do not use another sealer. (Details to follow with class information).Use her blender paint brushes. Mops do not work the same but you can use your other regular paint brushes for the projects.

Cheri Rol – October classes. The Pumpkin project is a beginner project and good one to start with for beginners.

Deco Art is discontinuing 30 different paint colors. Contact Barb for a copy of the list.

Mark Polmchak drawing results: Grapes painting – Diana Gelber; Lighthouse– Angie Kissel; There are 3 other paintings of Marks to be used for fund raising purposes this year.

**April GDA project** – painting with Sharpee markers on silk scarves. Barb has ordered and is ironing the silk scarves. The members need to purchase the markers in the colors you would like to use for the project. It was suggested to purchase at least a 12 pack and then select which ones you would like to use for the project after you see the samples being presented during the class. It will be team taught.
